### Feast days are from Sunset To Sunset

**Sabbath Day:** Weekly, 7<sup>th</sup> Day, Sunset Friday to Sunset Saturday

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep it Holy</li> <li>• Day of rest</li> <li>• No ordinary work</li> <li>• <b>Holy Convocation</b></li> </ul>	Exodus 16:25-30 Exodus 20:8-11 Exodus 31:12-15 Exodus 35:2 Leviticus 23:3

**Month:** The sighting of the ReNewed Moon in Israel begins the New Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acknowledge the new month by blowing a Shofar or making a joyful noise</li> <li>• Not required to assemble (<b>Exception: The 1<sup>st</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month, The Day of Trumpets</b>)</li> </ul>	Numbers 10:10 Numbers 28:11-14

**Biblical New Year:** 1<sup>st</sup> day of the First Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We are to guard (observe) the month of the Aviv or Abib</li> <li>• Not required to assemble. However, we assemble with our Online Community</li> </ul>	Exodus 12:1-2 Exodus 12:18 Deuteronomy 16:1

**Passover:** 14<sup>th</sup> Day of First Biblical Month of Aviv or Abib

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Evening Meal:</b> Lamb/Goat, Unleavened bread, Bitter herbs (Examples: Parsley, Horseradish, etc.)</li> <li>• Not required to assemble. However, we assemble for the meal with our Online Community</li> </ul>	Exodus 12:3-10 Leviticus 23:5 Numbers 9:14 Deuteronomy 16:1-8

**Unleavened Bread:** 14<sup>th</sup> Day of First Biblical Month of Aviv or Abib

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Days of the Feast are Holy Convocations</b></li> <li>• You are allowed to cook on the 1<sup>st</sup> day</li> <li>• No ordinary work on 1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> days</li> <li>• <b>Unleavened bread required to be eaten for 7 days</b></li> <li>• No Leaven allowed in food or homes during this week</li> <li>• <b>Firstfruits</b> are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10)</li> </ul>	Exodus 12:14-20 Exodus 12:43-48 Leviticus 23:6-8 Deuteronomy 16:3-4, 8 Leviticus 23:9-17 Deuteronomy 16:10 Deuteronomy 16:16-17

**Pentecost/ Feast of Weeks/ Shavuot**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Count 7 Sabbaths and 49 Days from the Sabbath within the Feast of Unleavened Bread</li> <li>• This is the 50<sup>th</sup> Day; it is always on a Sunday</li> <li>• <b>Holy Convocation</b></li> <li>• <b>Firstfruits</b> are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10)</li> </ul>	Leviticus 23 :9-21 Deuteronomy 16:9-12

**Day of Trumpets:** 1<sup>st</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No ordinary work</li> <li>• <b>Holy convocation with Trumpet and/or Shofar blasts</b></li> </ul>	Leviticus 23:23-25 Numbers 29:1

**Day of Atonement:** 10<sup>th</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Day of Affliction (Example: Fasting)</li> <li>• <b>Holy Convocation</b></li> </ul>	Leviticus 16:29-31 Leviticus 23:26-32 Numbers 29:7

**Feast of Tabernacles:** Starts on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Feast is for 7 days</li> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> Day wave branches/fruit and rejoice</li> <li>• Native born live in a temporary dwelling (Sukkah) for 7 days</li> <li>• <b>Holy Convocation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day</b></li> <li>• <b>Firstfruits</b> are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10)</li> </ul>	Leviticus 23:33-43 Numbers 29:12-39 Leviticus 23:9-17 Deuteronomy 16:13-15

**The Eighth Day:** 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Month
