Biblical New Year: 1st day of the First Biblical Month

Passover: 14th Day of First Biblical Month of Aviv or Abib

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Evening Meal: Lamb/Goat, Unleavened bread, Bitter herbs (Examples: Parsley, Horseradish, etc.) Not required to assemble. However, we assemble for the meal with our Online Community 	Exodus 12:3-10 Leviticus 23:5 Numbers 9:14 Deuteronomy 16:1-8

Unleavened Bread: 15th Day of First Biblical Month of Aviv or Abib

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st and 7th Days of the Feast are Holy Convocations You are allowed to cook on the 1st day No ordinary work on 1st and 7th days Unleavened bread required to be eaten for 7 days No Leaven allowed in food or homes during this week Firstfruits are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10) 	Exodus 12:14-20 Exodus 12:43-48 Leviticus 23:6-8 Deuteronomy 16:3-4, 8 Leviticus 23:9-17 Deuteronomy 16:10 Deuteronomy 16:16-17

Pentecost/ Feast of Weeks/ Shavuot

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count 7 weekly Sabbaths (and simultaneously 50 Days) from the Day of Firstfruits within the Feast of Unleavened Bread This is the 50th Day; it is always on a Sunday No ordinary work Holy Convocation Firstfruits are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10) 	Leviticus 23 :9-21 Deuteronomy 16:9-12

Day of Trumpets: 1st Day of the 7th Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No ordinary work Holy convocation with Trumpet and/or Shofar blasts 	Leviticus 23:23-25 Numbers 29:1

Day of Atonement: 10th Day of the 7th Biblical Month

Feast of Tabernacles / Sukkot: Starts on the 15th Day of the 7th Biblical Month

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Feast is for 7 days 1st Day wave branches/fruit and rejoice Dwell in a Sukkah (temporary dwelling) for 7 days No ordinary work Holy Convocation on the 1st day Firstfruits are given (The amount is determined by the giver; also recite Deuteronomy 26:5-10) 	Leviticus 23:33-43 Numbers 29:12-39 Leviticus 23:9-17 Deuteronomy 16:13-15
