Revelation 19:11-16

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Rev 19:12 His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

Rev 19:13 And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:14 And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Rev 19:16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

John 1:14

Jn 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Leviticus 23:39-43

Lev 23:39 Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto YeHoVaH seven days: on the first day *shall be* a sabbath, and on the eighth day *shall be* a sabbath.

Lev 23:40 And ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before YeHoVaH your God seven days.

Lev 23:41 And ye shall keep it a feast unto YeHoVaH seven days in the year. *It shall be* a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month.

Lev 23:42 Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in **booths**:

Lev 23:43 That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I *am* YeHoVaH your God.

Booths – **05521** סֹכֶת *cukkah* {sook-kaw'}

Meaning: 1) thicket, covert, booth 1a) thicket 1b) booth (rude or temporary shelter)

Usage: AV - tabernacle 12, booth 11, pavilion 5, cottage 1, covert 1, tents 1; 31

How long did the Children of Israel dwell in booths?

Deuteronomy 8

Dt 8:1 All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, **that ye may live**, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which YeHoVaH sware unto your fathers.

Dt 8:2 And thou shalt remember all the way which YeHoVaH thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Dt 8:3 And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every *word* that proceedeth out of the mouth of YeHoVaH doth man **live**.

Mt 4:4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not **live** by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

Live – **2198** ζῶω {dzah'-o}

Meaning: 1) to live, breathe, be among the living (not lifeless, not dead) 2) to enjoy real life 2a) to have true life and worthy of the name 2b) active, blessed, endless in the kingdom of God 3) to live i.e. pass life, in the manner of the living and acting 3a) of mortals or character 4) living water, having vital power in itself and exerting the same upon the soul 5) metaph. to be in full vigour 5a) to be fresh, strong, efficient, 5b) as adj. active, powerful, efficacious

Usage: AV - live 117, be alive 9, alive 6, quick 4, lively 3, not tr 1, misc 2, vr live 1; 143

Dt 8:4 Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these forty years.

Dt 8:5 Thou shalt also consider in thine heart, that, as a man chasteneth his son, so YeHoVaH thy God chasteneth thee.

Dt 8:6 Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of YeHoVaH thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.

Dt 8:7 For YeHoVaH thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills;

Dt 8:8 A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and honey;

Dt 8:9 A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any *thing* in it; a land whose stones *are* iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.

Dt 8:10 When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless YeHoVaH thy God for the good land which he hath given thee.

Dt 8:11 Beware that thou forget not YeHoVaH thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

Dt 8:12 Lest *when* thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt *therein*;

Dt 8:13 And *when* thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied;

Dt 8:14 Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget YeHoVaH thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;

Dt 8:15 Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, *wherein were* fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where *there was* no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint;

Dt 8:16 Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

Dt 8:17 And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of *mine* hand hath gotten me this wealth.

Dt 8:18 But thou shalt remember YeHoVaH thy God: for *it is* he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as *it is* this day.

Dt 8:19 And it shall be, if thou do at all forget YeHoVaH thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.

Dt 8:20 As the nations which YeHoVaH destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of YeHoVaH your God.
