Introduction

When we come into the Body of Messiah, we have to understand that the Father has laid out in His Word how we are to relate to one another. What is interesting about the Torah is that YeHoVaH has given us His Instructions. He is given us the Way, the code, the Instructions on how we are to conduct ourselves as representatives of the Almighty.

I was just talking to my son trying to help my son understand, along with my family members and others, that I, as a man, did not know how to be a man until I began to read and study the Torah.

I knew how to be a worldly man. I knew how to be a Christian man. In the Christian church, they do not tell you how to be a man of God or a godly man, you kind of figure that stuff out as you go and you watch the men in the church.

Unfortunately for me, unlike many of you, I had a lot of bad examples. I had cheating deacons, lying elders and preachers who were into all kinds of stuff. I had to make a decision: Was that the kind of man I wanted to be? And I remember reflecting.

This is why I got a message for us today that is going to deal with the entire family because this is what we are really about. We are about dealing with everybody and everything, and there's nothing that we should be hiding or should be ashamed of, which is why I try to be as transparent as I possibly can with people

because I know the façade. I know the fakeness of religion.

I know how people can carry a big, nice, shiny Bible but be full of dead men's bones. I know how people can talk, write, and speak holy and look like their life is in order, when behind the scenes it is just a mess. I know how pastors can stand in the pulpit and preach powerful messages, but then at home their life stinks. No respect from their wives. No respect from their children, and vice versa.

So, I know how that can be and I know how church can paint a picture, and how the religious community can paint a picture for people to look at that particular picture, when the fact of the matter is that the picture that people see is not what it is behind the scenes. How many of you know we know how to be good fakes? So, this is not about being a fake.

Christian Godly Men

When I was in the Christian church, I learned how to be a Christian man from other Christian men, not from the Bible. The Bible told me to love my wife like Christ loved the church. How many of you heard that one? Well, **how** do you do that?

They never told me **how** to love my wife like Christ loved the church, the only thing was,

"You just gotta be willing to die for her, Brother."

"Be willing to die for her? What does that mean?"

Does that mean if somebody breaks into my house, I get between her and the gun that is about to shoot my wife and put my life on the line for her? Is that what that means? Does it mean that I have to be willing to die to myself? It was never explained.

How many of you ever had that explained to you in the church? How is a husband supposed to love his wife like Christ loved the church? How is a woman, a wife, supposed to submit to her husband as unto the Lord? Now, we have all been told how we are supposed to do that,

"You are supposed to submit. I am the head of the house."

We throw those words around like there is some magical, mystical, spiritual power that is going to cause somebody to transform into that godly wife or that godly husband.

The New Testament does not tell us how to live. It does not tell us how we are to conduct our lives on a daily basis; it just tells us that we are to live holy. That we are to be holy.

What does that mean? How does that look?

When I did the teaching, A Spirit-Filled Life: What Walking in the Spirit Looks Like, I gave examples from the Bible showing how people are to conduct themselves and how they are to live their lives on a daily basis.

Many of us, including myself, knew how to live a Christian life on Sunday during the Sunday service. I knew how to live on Sunday because I was looking around and watching how other people were living. I was in the church trying to figure out how to carry my Bible.

"Well, you know, the really pious people carry their Bible like this." [Arthur puts the Bible under his arm.]

"Right?"

I am coming in there from the military. You put your books in the back of your pants. You walk up there like a grunt or a sailor or whatever the case may be, with your Bible in the back of your pants, but that is not how religious people, pious people, carry their Bibles.

We learned a lot of stuff from what we saw other people do, right? But when it came down to being a man of God, I did not have it in my home, and if you do not have that model in your home then you are not going to know, so you have to look around as to how you are going to do that.

My dad taught me, "Man does what he pleases; woman does what you tell her". That is how I grew up. It almost cost me my marriage, but I believed that because that is what my father taught me.

Living Holy

Now, here I am trying to live holy.

"Well, how do you live holy?"

You see, every one of us has to figure this out on our own if we are New Testament-only Believers.

But how many of you know the Torah tells you how to live holy? How many of you know the Torah tells you how to love your wife?

- The Torah teaches you how to be a man.
- The Torah teaches you how you are to conduct yourselves in a community.
- The Torah teaches you how you are to treat your neighbor.
- The Torah teaches you how you are to approach the Almighty.

You will never learn these things from the Gospel of Matthew to the Book of Revelation. I know I did not and I am preaching. I am a minister. I am a pastor. I am ordained. Are you following what I am saying? And I am still trying to figure this thing out.

You go home ...

"How am I supposed to treat my wife? How am I supposed to treat my children?"

"I don't know."

The Bible says, "Do not provoke your children."

"How do I keep from provoking my children unto wrath?"

"Well, what does that mean? How do I not do it?"

"Don't touch the unclean thing."

"What is an unclean thing? How do I know not to touch it?"

All the time not only I am touching the unclean stuff, but I am also putting it in my body. I am putting it on my body. I am living in the midst of it with people who are just as defiled and unclean as I am, and I do not have a clue. Talking about:

2 Corinthians 6:17 "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you."

What that meant for me was to stop going to the bar. That is what it meant to me. You know, do not be going to the dope house. Do not be hanging out with people who do not believe like you believe.

So, you hang out with other Christians and you come to find out that Christians are just as devious. As a matter of fact folks, in the church, I lost a lot of respect for Christians.

As a Christian, you would think that if you are dealing with a Christian businessman that you are going to get paid when you do your work. You think that

if you are dealing with a Christian person, they are not going to try to screw you. Not going to try to take advantage of you. Not going to try to get you to do something for nothing. That they have just scales and balances; just weights and measures.

"Just weights and measures? What is that?"

You follow what I am saying?

I knew Christian businessmen who were conniving, who would scheme, and who would do lousy work and cut corners. It got to the point to where if somebody said.

"Well, I am a Christian."

I almost wanted to get away from them. I would rather do business with a sinner because at least I know what I am dealing with.

"Brother, that is kind of cruel."

"I am just telling you how it is."

So how do you love your wife? I did not learn how to love my wife until I started studying the Torah and the Torah taught me something. Can I tell you the most valuable lesson that I have learned that has done more for me in loving my wife than anything I have ever read, studied, or tried to live?

The thing that taught me the most about loving my wife was the Law of Niddah. It taught me respect. It taught me honor. It taught me separation and space because for seven to eight days I am not supposed to touch her.

"How will you do that?" For seven or eight days, I am to separate from her while we are in close proximity. I have to pass her and not touch her. That is discipline. I have to look at her and smile at her, but I cannot touch her. This is the Torah teaching me. The Torah teaches me.

It created a whole level of thinking that I had never thought before because now I have to be aware of what I sit on, what I lay on, what I touch. It created this barrier between her and me, that during that time she was separated <u>unto</u> YeHoVaH and separated <u>from</u> me. For that time, my wife was the daughter of YeHoVaH.

For that period of time, I learned discipline, but it also taught me a deeper love and desire to be with her, and I could hardly wait until that eight-day period had passed. That is how I learned respect for my wife.

From the Torah, teaching my children, because by teaching my children these things, I am teaching them how to honor, love, and respect their wives long before they ever get married simply through practice. Someone might say,

"That's antiquated."

"Well, yeah. That is why you got your wife in bondage. That is why you got your thumb on her."

Most men cannot honor or respect their wives because, first of all, they cannot see them as equal, as an equal partner. This is what the church taught me. The church taught me how to suppress my wife. It taught me how to hold her down, how to put her under my thumb, how to control her. That is what religion

does; it teaches you how to control. And you do not stop there, you start trying to control everything around you. That is the spirit of witchcraft. It is a controlling, conniving, manipulative spirit that comes straight from the pit of Hell and YeHoVaH has nothing to do with that.

Through His Torah, He is trying to teach us, first of all, how to honor Him. I certainly cannot come into His presence and treat my wife any kind of way. Peter is talking from the Torah, when he said,

1 Peter 3:7 "Husbands, do not deal harshly with your wife or your prayers will be hindered."

How many Christian men, how many supposedly Torah-observant, supposedly Messianic, supposedly Hebrew Roots are trying to control and manipulate their spouse and wonder why they cannot get a prayer through.

I am preaching already, so do not try to stop me because we need deliverance. We need to be healed.

You Brothers, and you Sisters, listen to me because I am trying to share something with you that I think will add a whole new dimension of spirituality in your home. If you believe that the mate the Father has blessed you with is from the Father, then her role in your life is to help you. That is a role. That means she brings something to the table.

The beauty of this is that the whole burden, like the church wants to teach us, of the household being on the man is not true. The burden of that household is on the shoulder of that husband and wife whom YeHoVaH said are to be one. That is what it is. When you become one, you share. That is what you do. That means that

you are not the only brain in the house. There are two brains.

Get this,

Matthew 18:19 "...If two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven."

I believe that Scripture has a lot to do with husbands and wives, the two becoming one. You understand what I am saying? And if you do not know how to become one with your spouse, with your mate, you become one by yourself. Let that sink in. It is called divorce. There are so many divorced people because they do not understand the Bible.

Back in 1990, George Barna stated, in a research report that divorce in the church, the House of God, began to exceed divorce in the world. So, you have people who are supposed to have the Word of God in their hand, who carry it religiously under their shoulder like pious people, but do not apply what is being taught in the Book.

When I began to listen to what my wife had to say, she said things that hurt my feelings. She said things that I did not like. She said things that made me angry, but she loved me. It reminds me of YeHoVaH, who loves His people so much so that He will say to them what they need to hear and it is not pleasant when it comes.

I am talking to some wives who are thinking about how to get out of their marriage. I am talking to some husbands who are so oppressive that they do not even realize that their wife is scheming and that one day they are going to come home and she is going to be gone. All the signs are there.

If you do not know or learn how to treat your mate, like your mate, understanding first and foremost that she is the daughter of the Most High ... According to the writer of Proverbs,

Proverb 18:22 "Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD".

My wife got a hold of that verse. She reminds me whenever I get out of line where my favor comes from. You want to talk about favor? Let me tell you something, the favor comes through that wife because she is going to teach you how to be a man, how to be a husband.

"Well, my wife can't teach me anything."

"That is your problem."

She cannot teach you anything. Yet, you say she was given to you by YeHoVaH. Well, if He gave her to you, He is trying to teach you something through her. And if she cannot teach you anything then you are going to miss it, and you will be on to the next one. Then, to the next one. If you do not learn your lesson, you are going to grow up to be a single, old man. Alone.

John writes this letter to encourage Gaius to continue to help those whom he sent and to stand even though Diotrephes, a leader in the congregation, wanted to have the preeminence, or to be first, and refused to accept those sent by John as missionaries.

JUDE

Jude was combating false teachings and false teachers who appeared to be teaching a type of "once saved always saved" doctrine and that nothing you could do would cause you to lose your salvation. Thus, grace gave you a license to live however you chose to and nothing you did could change your salvation status.

The Fruit of the Spirit (Paperback)
